## INTRODUCTION

The "Series Rough Pitch - The Balkan Way 2" took place online, on November 7, 2022, in Zagreb/Croatia.

The Pitching Event was hosted and moderated by the CED - MEDIA Office Croatia, in collaboration with the Creative Europe MEDIA Offices from Bulgaria, Greece, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia. It was realised through the collaboration with the Croatian Audiovisual Centre, the Film Centre Serbia, the Bulgarian National Film Centre, the Film Centre of Montenegro, the Film Agency of North Macedonia and supported by the CED MEDIA Offices from Austria and Germany (Berlin - Brandenburg).

Aiming the event at development stage TV series fiction, **7 projects were pitched online** to a jury of industry experts: **Andrea Hoffmann** / Berlinale Co-production Market / Co-Pro Series Coordinator, **Mira Staleva** / Sofia Meetings / CEO, **Nadja Radojevic** / European Showrunner Programme / ifs Internationale Filmschule Köln / CEO, **Solène Moreau** / Series Mania Forum / Writers Campus / Coordinator, **Angelica Cantisani** / TorinoFilmLab / Programmes Coordinator, **Susanne Spellitz** / ORF / TV Commissioning Editor and **Grace Maharaj** / WIFT Sweden / Board Member.

The call was open for participants coming from **Albania**, **Bosnia and Herzegovina**, **Bulgaria**, **Croatia**, **Greece**, **Montenegro**, **North Macedonia**, **Serbia and Slovenia**. A total of 37 projects were received, out of which 8 were selected. Prior to the pitching event, the **PITCH PREPARATION WORKSHOP** was organised and led by the experienced, international coaches **Valeria Richter** (scriptwriter) and **Helene Granqvist** (producer).

HOST & MODERATOR of the Event

Martina Petrović holds a major in International Relations and minor in Psychology. Martina gained most of her professional experience at the Ministry of Culture, Department for International Cultural Cooperation, being responsible for various cultural exchange programmes between Croatia and other countries; among many activities, she was responsible for the organisation of Croatian film presentations at international film festivals in Berlin and Cannes. From 2008, she was actively involved in establishing the Croatian AV Centre, where she stayed, after being appointed by the EC as the Head of MEDIA Desk Croatia.

Following immediate and successful Croatian MEDIA results, she was awarded the first Albert Kapović Award by the Croatian Producers Association in 2010. Ever since, she has been actively involved in organising innovative and creative workshops – important tools for education, information and networking between Croatian and European film professionals.

CREATIVE EUROPE DESK - MEDIA Office Croatia is a promotion and information office for the European Commission's MEDIA Sub-programme which offers a wide variety of funding for film and television, video games and activities ranging from training to development and distribution to markets, events and festivals. Since September 2008 it is hosted by the Croatian AV Centre. It offers advice and answers enquiries from Croatian film and TV professionals and gamers, explaining various funding strands and eligibility criteria, organising various workshops, info days and lectures.

"Following a successful pilot edition which gathered more than 10,000 viewers in total, the second Series Rough Pitch – The Balkan Way was live-streamed on 7th of November, 2022.

In response to the high demand for TV series and in order to keep up with the needs of the European and global TV market scene, the Balkan region pitching platform has invited the same tutors again: Swedish producer Helene Granqvist and Danish scriptwriter Valeria Richter. Both professionals helped the selected projects and their teams to work on their stories and their intriguing presentations prior to the online live pitching event.

The call was open to participants coming from nine countries:
Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece,
Montenegro, North Macedonia, Slovenia, and Serbia. Three of
the seven projects chosen among the 24 received in total are from
Croatia and two are from Greece, while Bulgaria and Serbia are
represented by one project each.

By organising Series Rough Pitch - The Balkan Way, we seek to safeguard, develop and promote European cultural and linguistic diversity but also to increase the competitiveness and the economic potential of the audiovisual sector from the Balkan region. At the same time, we also respect each project's uniqueness and its author by developing safe spaces for culturally diverse stories.

MARTINA PETROVIĆ

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Helene Granqvist and Valeria Richter have gathered significant experience in the international film- and TV industry and collaborated on several film projects and coaching events together. Between them, they cover a wide range of fiction, documentary and TV-series production and writing, as well as financing and organizing innovative development, production and script consulting labs, having created new training concepts for both young talents and experienced filmmakers. Currently they are financing a new lab format and industry wide initiative that focuses on sustainability and new ways to approach much needed change across the ecosystem of how we develop, produce and connect films- and TV series to audiences.



#### HELENE GRANQVIST

Producer

Helene is a prizewinning producer, who has worked with film and television for more than 30 years. Her films have been represented at festivals all over the world - such as Sundance, Cannes, Toronto and San Sebastian. She is frequently being engaged as a pitch coach and lecturer, both in Sweden and internationally. Since 2013, Helene has been president of the board of Women in Film & Television, Sweden and since 2018, president for Women in Film & Television International She's a member of the European Film Academy and one of the founding members of ARTEF (Anti-Racist Task Force for European Film). Helene is based in southern Sweden.



#### VALERIA RICHTER

Scriptwriter

Valeria works internationally and writes, develops and consults in the areas of feature film, TV series, lab innovation, script development and pitch coaching since 1997; she regularly consults for various funds, industry events and film institutes. She is head writer/creator of the TV drama series, Next of Kin (to premiere on Elisa Viihde in 2022). Valeria developed several lab concepts such as the 3-year Nordic Genre Boost for Nordisk Film & TV Fond, POWR and EmPOWR Lab for Industry@Tallinn Baltic Event and created the Audience Design concept for TorinoFilmLab, whom she has worked for since the start in 2008. Valeria holds an MA in Film & Media Science; is a member of EFA and the Danish Writers' Guild. She is based in Copenhagen, Denmark.
